



The Mission Adopt-A-Block Society's **Annual Spring & Fall Clean-Up Events**

We Invite Your Non-Profit Organization to participate in our Municipal Spring/Fall Clean-up Events ...

With the encouragement and financial support of The District of Mission and as a part of our on-going "Anti-Litter Campaign", to educate and raise awareness to the litter problems in our city, Mission Adopt-A-Block invites all Mission non-profits to participate in our Annual Spring Clean-Up Event.

The Spring & Fall Clean-Up events, entails the acceptance of eight(8) non-profit groups to participate in a community wide litter clean-up. Participating groups are responsible for the cleaning up of litter on public walkways, curbs, public green spaces, ditches, etc. on their assigned route, while Mission Adopt-A-Block supplies the equipment, bags, etc. and oversees the removal of the collected "litter" garbage bags. This clean-up event is a great opportunity for Mission non-profit organizations to gain both financial and good citizenship benefits for their organizations.

Interested Mission non-profit groups must submit their application for these annual events before their deadlines: **Spring Cleanup Deadline is Jan 30th & Fall Cleanup Deadline is June 30th**

Participants will be selected by a lottery process within 2 weeks of the deadline. *(Groups that have participated in Annual Clean-Ups for two(2) years in a row, will not be eligible for this lottery – and will only be considered if the maximum of 8 groups is not filled by other candidates, after which, a second lottery will be drawn, and therefore all non-profit groups are encouraged to submit applications.)*

Each group selected to participate in the Spring & Fall Clean-Ups will be awarded up to \$400 (\$20 per participant to a maximum of \$400) upon the completion of the assigned litter route – as detailed by Adopt-A-Block. Selected applicants will be informed of their selection and be given an information package to begin the coordination of their team.

This is a great opportunity for Mission non-profit organizations to raise funds to support their programs and all Mission non-profits are welcome to apply to be Spring or Fall Clean-Up participants to receive these funds. What is more, this is an excellent opportunity to teach environmental social responsibility and to participate in a very rewarding community project that benefits all citizens and aspects of Mission.

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Please Note: **We will not accept any late applications.** All applications that meet the deadline and other criteria below will be selected by means of a random lottery process.

Spring & Fall Clean-Up Event Details: (please read carefully)

- ◆ Applicants for receiving funds from the Spring & Fall Clean-Up Events **must** be a Mission (B.C.) non-profit organization.
- ◆ The Spring Clean-Up will be held over four(4) Saturdays during the months of **April & May**. The Fall Clean-Up will be held over four(4) Saturdays during the months of **September & October**.
- ◆ The amount of **up to \$400** will be awarded to participating groups – this amount will reflect the length and difficulty of the route to be cleaned and the number of participants that the group provides..
- ◆ A minimum of 15 volunteers must participate per group to obtain remuneration amount. Groups can earn up to \$400 based on the number of participants they have in attendance. We award \$20 per participant up to a maximum of \$400 per group. Note: *The minimum amount of volunteers is needed to complete the route successfully.*
- ◆ For safety reasons, all volunteers **must be age 10+**, and relatively fit. **(Our liability coverage prohibits participation under the age of ten(10) and therefore, arrangements must be made for alternative care of children or siblings of the volunteers on clean-up day. Please emphasize this to all of your recruits!)**
- ◆ The duration of the clean-up is approximately 2-3 hours and is dependent on the amount of volunteers recruited for the event.
- ◆ Mission Adopt-A-Block will:
 1. Supply efficient equipment to pick up the litter
 2. Supply safety vests, guidance and a safety talk for your group
 3. Be responsible for disposing of the bags of litter and recycling you have collected
 4. Have an Adopt-A-Block representative in attendance at every clean-up
- ◆ Steps to a successful clean-up are as follows:
 - 1) Groups will return the completed application to Adopt-A-Block by the **DEADLINE** (see above)

- 2) Mission Adopt-A-Block will inform successful groups of their assigned routes and confirm dates within 3 weeks of the closing deadline. Your group will be matched with an appropriate route.
- 3) Groups must recruit their volunteers and inform recruited volunteers of all relevant information supplied by Mission Adopt-A-Block, **in advance** of the clean-up date.
- 4) Groups must inform Mission Adopt-A-Block well in advance of any changes that will affect their participation.
- 5) Groups must sign a commitment and waiver form the day of the clean-up and be responsible for direct supervision of their volunteers on the day of the clean-up. (Make sure to recruit sufficient adult volunteers to mind youth volunteers)
- 6) Upon completion of the clean-up of the **entire** route, to Mission Adopt-A-Block's satisfaction, ***you will receive remuneration within 2 weeks following the completion of the Annual Spring & Fall Clean-up***).
